Supervisor: Director Maintenance Technology

Function: Perform and accomplish in a critical time period, pre-flight and post flight functional operations and maintenance services.

Essential Functions:

1. Perform a variety of aircraft maintenance operations, including maintaining, servicing, installing and repairing a variety of aircraft systems
2. Perform structural assembly and riveting operations in the fabrications and installation of minor, sub and major assemblies and components
3. Perform schedule and unscheduled phase maintenance on engines and remove and install as required
4. Operate ground support equipment
5. Work from blueprints, electronic data, operations and work orders and verbal instructions
6. Adhere to all applicable safety and operations procedures and directives
7. Maintain schedules and quality standards
8. Notify supervision of any/all malfunctions, defect and damages of equipment, material and product
9. Work, cooperate and communicate with supervisors, program managers, customers and co-workers satisfactorily, this includes the professional, mature acceptance of constructive criticism.
10. Comply with the policies and procedures as set forth in the TSM Corporation employee handbook
11. Perform other duties as required.

Qualifications:

1. A&P License or High School diploma with a minimum of eight (8) years experience, performing maintenance on the type of aircraft supported by the assigned contract.

General Physical Requirements:

- Lifting, standing, walking, bending, climbing, grasping, carrying, holding, pushing and pulling are generally required to perform functions of this position.
