INTRODUCTION: The TRADET Instructor duties involve providing operational training to personnel within Navy Special Warfare Command.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. Working with various training cells, assists in the planning and executing of training movements for Navy Special Warfare Command.
2. Drafts schedules, prepares messages and reports, obtains quotas, coordinates schools, updates training records and requests/tracks assets.
3. Works with TRADET Operations and other organizations to schedule training areas and platforms (GOPLAT), ship, small craft, helos, and aircraft), arranges transportation of personnel and equipment and coordinates training site logistical needs.
4. Coordinates and organizes role players for field training exercises.
5. Budgets, orders, receives, issues, and maintains inventory control on common parts and consumables.
6. Serves as ADVON to prepare training site and service on-site logistical support systems.
7. Must be familiar with and have experience with mountaineering, rock climbing, rappelling and specialized rope work to include Climbing Fundamentals, Mountain Medicine, River and Stream Crossing, High Angle Rescue, Avalanche Safety, and Mountaineering Equipment. Instructor will be expected to participate and perform in all phases of the mountaineering training.
8. Develops curriculum and lesson training guides for use by students in actual training exercises.
9. Liaisons with NSWG-1 component commands concerning WRT training schedules, equipment and personnel shortfalls.
10. Performs other administrative and other instructional support duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR POSITION:

1. Must be able to obtain as a minimum a Secret Security Clearance.
2. Must be knowledgeable of NSW Mission, Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (TTPs), Mission Essential Tasks (METLs) and Training Requirements.
3. Must be familiar with static and dynamic range training evolutions, Immediate Action Drills (IADS), small unit patrolling, method of entry breaching and the safe use of small arms and demolitions.
4. Must be familiar with and have experience with mountaineering, rock climbing, rappelling and specialized rope work as well as perform the tasks that are being taught.
5. Must have 10+ years of training in mountaineering skills snow, ice, rock and altitude.
6. Must be an expert skier and capable of teaching basic to expert instruction on downhill AT skis.
7. Must have experience in instructing and climbing 5.8 to 5.11 rocks.
8. Hold certifications for Mountaineering skills through NOLS, EXUM or AAI (American Alpine Institute).
9. Have experience in High Angle Rescue techniques.
10. Be willing to travel out of state for up to four weeks to support training.
11. Be willing to travel out of state for up to six weeks for certification or re-certification training.
12. Comply with policies and procedures as set forth in the Corporation's Handbook of Policy and Procedures.

- 13. Comply with provisions of Corporation's Standard Practice Procedures manual and DoD 5220.22-M when handling classified information to include generating, marking, storing, handling, and destroying classified material.
